- 16-17 years old
- Language proficiency A2-B1
- EFL class

## Learning outcome:

 Students will be able to write an instructional instagram post using new vocabulary.

#### Lesson outline:

- Flipped classroom: creating a word cloud with specific vocabulary
  - Warm-up: guessing & predicting based on key words
    - Speaking: describing a process
  - Peers' assessment of oral presentations using rubric
    - Writing HOW TO instagram post
    - Peers' assessment of written tasks using checklist
      - Commenting & voting on Padlet
      - Wrap-up: reflecting on vocabulary acquisition

#### Lesson plan:

#### FLIPPED CLASSROOM:

1.Students got links to prepare
vocabulary in order to describe a
treatment in a beauty salon (they
can choose what to present)
2.They are asked to create a word
cloud/ find the photos showing
phases of the process/explore
instagram

WARM-UP(10 min):
Students reveal KEY
words and the rest
of the class guess
what they are going
to deal with.

SPEAKING (15 min):

Describe a chosen
treatment. Comment
peers' oral
presentation(according
to rubric).
